

## Dunstable Tennis Club – court booking arrangements Summer 2010

### Priority use of courts

**Coaching.** Coaching staff have priority use:

Monday to Friday	9am to 7pm	-	any 3 courts
Tuesdays	7pm to 9.30pm	-	courts 4 & 5 only
Wednesday	7pm to 9.30 pm	-	court 6 only
Thursday	7pm to 9.30pm	-	court 6 OR courts 4 & 5
Friday	7pm to 9.30pm	-	court 6 only
Saturday	1pm to close	-	up to 3 courts

**League Matches.** Courts 1&2 may be in use for Beds and South Beds matches on Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and Sunday afternoons. If there are 2 matches on a Thursday, they will be played on courts 1&2 and 4&5. Junior matches may be arranged on Saturday morning and / or afternoons. If there is no match (check match schedule on the wall and booking sheets), the courts can be booked.

**Social Play.** All courts other than court 6 are reserved for social play on Wednesday and Friday evenings between 7pm and 9.30 pm (some may be available before then, check with coach), and courts 1-3 on Sunday mornings up until 1pm.

**Club and South Beds tournaments.** From and including Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> July, courts cannot be booked for tournament matches on social evenings. To help people arrange matches, the following court time is made available for booking club tournament matches. If not booked for tournament matches, they can be booked for social matchplay.

Monday	7pm to 9.30pm	-	court 6
Tuesday & Thursday	7pm to 9.30pm	-	court 3

Members can also arrange tournament matches at weekends, court time permitting.

**Special tournaments, school summer camps etc.** Occasionally the committee will authorise use of courts by schools or other tournaments, particularly in half term and between term holidays. Such use takes priority over normal booking arrangements – check booking sheets.

### General court booking arrangements

The court booking sheets must be used to reserve courts (subject to priority use as above).

Courts can be booked up to two weeks in advance. If coaches have not reserved courts for the Tuesday or Thursday by Monday of the same week, members can assume that the courts are available.

If you no longer need to use a court that has already been booked, please erase the booking so others can use the court. Please be realistic about how much time is needed for your booking.

If floodlights are used, money should be left in the red cashbox behind the bar or the box on the wall. The cost of lights is £1 per 30 minutes.

**Floodlights must not be used at weekends** other than with the permission of the committee because of planning and use restrictions.
