- SENIOR** : **£160** (*Over 25*)  
**(£150 if paid in full before 31st March 2010, £160 if paid by 4 instalments started by 31st March 2010)**
- FAMILY** : **£340** (*Adult members with or without a partner and their children, under 25 at any point in the membership year, all of whom must live at the same principle permanent residence*)  
**(£315 if paid in full before 31st March 2010, £340 if by 4 instalments started by 31st March 2010)**
- OFF-PEAK** : **£90** (*Permitted to play Mon – Fri, 9 am to 5 pm only*)
- COUNTRY** : **£90** (*Reside 25 miles or more from the club by shortest road route*)
- SENIOR CITIZEN** : **£90** (*Aged 65 or over in the membership year*)
- INTERMEDIATE** : **£90** (*Under 25 or improved junior under 18, invited to play at senior level*)
- JUNIOR** : **£70** (*Aged 10 - 18*)
- MINI TENNIS (under 10)\*** : **£20** (*\* born 2000 or later*)
- SOCIAL** : **£20** (*Non playing member*)

**DISCOUNTS:**

For British Tennis members, **deduct £10** from the above fees. (For family membership each person must be a BT member. A completed, signed registration British Tennis membership form can be submitted with this application to qualify for the discount).

The following additional incentives are available to full playing members only.
