The club is located off Downs Road at the foot of Blows Downs. There are now three artificial grass courts and three artificial clay courts and a small clubhouse. The club is affiliated to the Lawn Tennis Association (LTA) and encourages members to join British Tennis. Membership of British Tennis is free and benefits both members and the club. DTC is also Tennis Clubmark accredited and is a registered Community Amateur Sports Club (CASC).

The Junior section

The Junior section depends on a team of adult member volunteers who give their time freely, we are always looking for willing volunteers to help out during junior sessions, to run the 'tuck shop', co-ordinate teams, or provide lifts to matches. Please let us know if you would be able to help.

When to play

There are a variety of tennis related activities for children from the age of 5 upwards including:

Introductory coaching	<i>Saturday morning sessions</i>
Practice Play	<i>Saturday mornings & Monday evenings</i>
Club tournaments	<i>During the summer</i>
Club league	<i>Winter Saturday mornings</i>
Holiday camps	<i>During school holidays</i>

Juniors may use courts at other times if not restricted by matches and social play, and if supervised by an adult. It may be possible for non-playing parents to obtain access to the club for their children to play at certain times, please discuss this with a committee member if you are interested.

Policy for Safeguarding Children

The club is committed to maintaining a safe environment for children to play and enjoy tennis. The Child Protection Policy is displayed on the Junior notice board. We also have an elected Child Protection Officer who is available to discuss any issues you may have.

We are working towards a position where all adult members regularly involved in the coaching and supervision of children have been through CRB checks and work to a job description.

IMPORTANT – Parents' Responsibilities

The club cannot be responsible for supervising your children outside the organised sessions on Saturday mornings and Monday evenings.

Sessions may be cancelled in the event of bad weather so parents should make sure a session is on before leaving their children at the gates.

The Club is not responsible for children once they leave the club grounds.

Medical Information

Parents of Juniors will be required to complete a medical declaration for each junior member to be used in the case of an emergency.

Types of Junior membership & costs

Mini Tennis	£20*	<i>10 and under, i.e. born in 2000 or later.</i>
Junior	£70	<i>Aged 10 to 18</i>
Junior Intermediate	£90	<i>Junior players who have reached adult standard and by nomination of the junior committee can play during adult sessions and represent the senior teams in matches</i>

A discount of £10 is applied to the above categories if the Junior is also a member of British Tennis. (A completed, signed registration British Tennis membership form can be submitted with this application to qualify for the discount).

Additional discounts for Junior and Junior Intermediate (not Mini Tennis) are available where parents are members. There is also a family rate and the club always welcomes new players of any standard. Contact the Membership Secretary, Phillip Moss for more details.

* The Mini Tennis membership fee is levied in addition to a £2 per session coaching charge. The Junior fee includes 1 hours free coaching per week
