The 2011 audited annual accounts will be posted on the Clubhouse notice board one week prior to the meeting.

Please remember that subscriptions will be due on 31st March 2012 and please note the due dates for payment which will be strictly adhered to.

The Committee is proposing a change to the subscription rates by removing the £10 increase imposed last year for each membership category. However, the £10 discount offered last year for British Tennis Members will also be removed.

British Tennis Members will, therefore, find their subscription rates unchanged.

Early payment discounts still apply to those paying in full by 1st April and there will be the option to pay by Standing Order, 10 monthly payments from April.
